This facility provides residential crisis stabilization services and mobile crisis response to individuals who are experiencing a mental health crisis or emergency. Our facility is designed to develop and enhance psychiatric stability, personal and emotional adjustment, self-sufficiency, and the necessary skills to live in a more independent setting.

- On-Call working part time, shifts from 5:00 pm to 8:00 am

### **JOB DUTIES**

- Provide short term intensive mental health intervention to provide relief of distress based on a determination that the client's behavior is a serious deviation from his/ her baseline level of functioning.
- Complete documentation in an accurate and timely manner.
- Assess in a culturally appropriate way the client's current life situation, source of stress, symptoms, risky behaviors and mental health problems.
- Evaluate client strengths and limitations, support network and functioning.
- Create a treatment plan that addresses the needs and problems identified in the assessment, identify short term goals with frequency and types of services to be provided, make recommendations and referrals to appropriate community resources, mental health services, emergency medical services, local law enforcement or county social services.
- Make referrals to community resources and maintain relationships with those resources.
- Contact licensed supervisor for consultation and supervision within minimum three hours of providing on-site services.
- Coordinate care with appropriate professionals including mandatory reporting and duty to warn when required.
- Establishes and maintains effective relationships with agency personnel, county and state officials and the community.
- Seeks out and participates in trainings to ensure that we are offering culturally and economically diverse services to the public.
- Performs related work as required.

## MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

To be considered a qualified Mental Health Practitioner you must meet one of the following qualifications:

- Have a Bachelor's degree in one of the behavioral sciences or related fields and at least 2,000 hours of supervised experience in the delivery of services to persons with mental illness. (In lieu of 2,000 hours, a BA-level graduate MHPR may work under the clinical supervision of a mental health professional at the rate of 1 hr. individual clinical supervision/week. This supervision must be documented by the MHP.)
- Have at least 6,000 hours of supervised experience in the delivery of services to persons with mental illness.
- Holds a master's or other graduate degree in one of the behavioral sciences or related fields.

All candidates must pass a pre-employment background screening.
